## ***The History of Giving***

Over the years, knowing how to donate to Bloys has become confusing to some. So, as we look forward to Bloys Campmeeting, it may be helpful to explain how your donations sustain and strengthen this sacred place and its mission for current and future generations to come.

The two main ways to donate annually are to the Bloys Campmeeting Association and to your cook shed:

### **1. Bloys Campmeeting Association**

- Checks and donations should be made payable to “Bloys Campmeeting Association”
  - Donations can be made during Bloys or sent throughout the year to the Bloys Campmeeting Association Treasurer, Maxie Watts, at the following addresses:

- Context:
  - 501 (c) 3 Non-profit organization that oversees Bloys Members from each cookshed/encampment make up representation of the Bloys Association Executive Board
    - The Association also has the following committees: Grounds, Youth, Finance, and Memorial
  - All donations are tax-deductible
- Primary responsibilities of Bloys Campmeeting Association:
  - Annual maintenance of grounds as a whole (approximately 640 acres) and fundamental water and electrical infrastructure for 450+ cabins and RV park for use during the one week of Camp Meeting
  - Use and maintenance of main Tabernacle and all children and youth worship facilities such as Chapel in the Rocks, Mabel Bloys Tabernacle, the Memorial Tabernacle and the Nabertacle.
  - Employment of worship leadership staff
  - Caretaker employment & Caretaker’s home
  - Opening and Closing cabins for use
  - Planning for future growth

### **2. Your Cook Shed/Encampment:**

- Each cook shed relies on your generous donations for continued operation (checks and donations should be made payable to):

- Primary Responsibilities:
  - Provide meals for its members throughout each Campmeeting
  - Each camp conducts its business as a separate entity and assumes different responsibilities for their camp as needed.

Additional donations can be made to both the memorial fund and the endowment fund of the Bloys Campmeeting Association.

- Memorial Fund:
  - Donations made to Bloys Campmeeting Association in memory of, or in honor of, an individual to assist with special capital improvements as needed. These donations are acknowledged to the family by completing the Memorial form found under the “Donate Now” tab on [www.bloyscampmeeting.org](http://www.bloyscampmeeting.org) site.
- Bloys Campmeeting Endowment Fund:
  - The Bloys Campmeeting Association Endowment Account is to receive donations to be invested, and to provide income from the investments of the funds to support the Bloys Campmeeting Association.
